Whereas, By the act of Congress, approved on the 17th day of July, 1854, entitled "An act to authorize the PRESIDENT of the UNITED STATES to cause to be surveyed the tract of land in the Territory of Minnesota belonging to the half breeds or mixed bloods of the Dacotah or Sioux nation of Indians, and for other purposes," to which Congress passed an amendatory act, approved May 19, 1858, in which said act of 1854 authority is given for the issue and location of Dacotah or Sioux half breed certificates or scrip; And whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the UNITED STATES a Certificate of the Register and Receiver of the Land Office at Otter Tail city No. 119. whereby it appears that Dacotah or Sioux half breed Certificate No. 176 B. for 80 acres, issued by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs in favor of Maria S. Godfroy has been located and surrendered by the said Maria S. Godfroy, in full satisfaction for the North half of the South East Quarter of Section Six, in Township One hundred and Thirty-two, North, of Range Thirty-two West of the fifth principal meridian, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Otter Tail city Minnesota, containing Eighty Acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Public Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, have Given and Granted, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Maria S. Godfroy and to her heirs the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Maria S. Godfroy and to her heirs and assigns forever.
